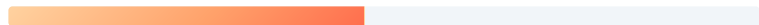

Illustrative sample report — the companies, events, figures, and period shown below are representative examples used to demonstrate Sightline's report format and depth. They are not drawn from a live monitoring period. Grid-scale battery storage was this week's standout topic in sustainability intelligence coverage, with NextEra Energy and First Solar both citing expanded storage-attached project pipelines in newsroom disclosures. Offshore wind held steady rather than growing, as Ørsted and Vestas discussed continued permitting and supply-chain timelines for existing projects rather than new announcements. Green hydrogen investment accelerated on the back of new DOE funding, and solar manufacturing reshoring continued at a steadier pace following last week's incentive-driven surge.

Battery storage overtakes offshore wind as the lead topic

NextEra Energy and First Solar both disclosed expanded storage-attached generation pipelines this week, continuing a shift in market attention from offshore wind toward grid-scale storage.

Green hydrogen funding accelerates

A new DOE funding announcement this week targeted electrolyzer manufacturing and hydrogen hub buildout, a topic this workspace flags as emerging after two quiet weeks.

Offshore wind: steady execution, not new announcements

Ørsted's and Vestas's disclosures this week focused on permitting and supply-chain progress for existing projects rather than new project announcements, consistent with the topic's flat week-over-week count.
